WAKING SLEEPING BEAUTY PART 4



I am nowhere as far along as I had hoped for this time of year. It seems like I have very little to show for my efforts since the last article. I guess it is

mainly because I have pushed some other projects ahead of the Mercedes. Things like going on vacation, putting insulation and flooring in the attic of the shop, running some wiring and hanging lights in the shop. This work is not completed but it is coming along very nicely.

I also bought a new camera so I should be able to post some pictures as I go along on the project. My old one broke and sharing a camera with Libby did not work out too well. I have included several pictures this time. One picture is of the car as It was when I brought it home. A couple pictures are of the car as it is now, and one picture is of two pieces I have fabricated for the AC unit. Maybe I can post more as I get more familiar with the camera and the process of downloading the pictures.

Before cold weather set in I did manage to do some paint work under the hood and paint some of the numerous pieces that I removed from under the hood. There is some more paint work that must be done, but I want to complete the AC fabrication work before I do that.

I could have bought an AC kit from an aftermarket supplier and saved a lot of work, but I could not find one that would fit exactly the way I think it should. Even the bought units require some rework to make them fit, because the manufacturer must make them fit a number of different cars. By sourcing the AC parts individually and fabricating whatever else I need, I will have a much cleaner, neater and more efficient AC unit. I calculate that I have saved 20 to 30 pounds over the unit that was originally on the car, not to mention the increased efficiency.

I am making one concession to originality and will try to use the under dash AC evaporator unit that came with the car. This is purely for the purpose of trying to keep the interior of the car looking original. If this doesn't work out, I will buy an aftermarket unit and use it.
