BREMC APRIL MEETING MINUTES

Meeting Date: Thursday, April 2nd, 2015

The meeting was called to order and greetings were brought by the club's president, **Skip Wise.** A delicious dinner was served at Deer Brook Country Club in Shelby, North Carolina.

Program: Guest Speaker Harvey Ferris, Jaguar Judge, will speak on how a classic car is evaluated during a concours/car show. Harvey joins us from New Hill, North Carolina, just outside of Raleigh. Bruce Harless and Harvey met at a Jaguar show last year at Little Switzerland and Bruce invited him to BREMC to speak to the club.

Health and Happiness Notes: Jeff Cox is still battling cancer but is at home. Cards may be sent to: 160 Oak Pointe Dr. Cherryville, NC 28021. Jeff would love to hear from club members. You may also email photos of great cars you see or just yourselves waving!

Old Business: Minutes from March read, corrections made. Minutes approved.

New members: Per Treasure Teague we have three new members; David Deal, Marvin McDonald, Jr., Bill Schreiner. Welcome to each of you, we're glad you have joined BREMC!

New Business:

- Bruce Harless discusses the recent Table Rock drive to Hickory and Paramount Classics. Lots of nice cars. Lunch at Hickory Tavern in old uptown Hickory. The Table Rock club is participating in our car classic in April.
- Last weekend several folks went to the South Carolina to the Casey (?) SC British car show #9. All from BREMC who attended placed. There were 100-150 cars in their show. Congratulations BREMC members!
- Reminder: MAY 23 Saturday, Southeastern British Motorcar Owners Club (SBMOC) will host an all British car show at *Furman University* in conjunction with *Greenville Scottish Games* (Great Scot!) Beautiful location. Our folks spoke very positively about the event.
- Samples of two BREMC letterheads are sent around for members to choose the one they prefer.
- Skip requests, if you have not paid this year's dues, please do so.
- Kurt let us know there is an MG for sale in Charlotte, just redone. Interested? Talk to Kurt.
- Mac indicates there are some more PR cards for the upcoming Broad River Classic available. Please take some with you this evening.

Upcoming Car Show Business:

- **Registration:** Per Treasure, at this point 45 people have registered, 27 of whom are members of BREMC. (16 paid by PayPal, 25 by check and 1 by cash.) We are on trend with our registration numbers. Usually, we have 68+/- registered prior to the day of the show with an additional 35-40 registering day of, if the weather is lovely
- **Raffle baskets**: Lundy indicates 15 baskets are pledged, 2 are in hand. The rest will be brought the day of the

- show. Other items may be donated as well. The monies raised benefit local charities. Bruce Harless suggests auctioning hourly instead of all at once to increase interest and catch more folks. No decision made on this suggestion.
- **Posters:** Skip shows posters for this year's classic. Sponsor poster is a photo taken by Tommy Greene of a '34 Rolls Royce. Special edition poster is a pen and ink drawing by Cindy Carlisle. Both are quite lovely and the club appreciates their contributions.
- **Trophies:** Mac indicates we have 22 firsts, 19 seconds and 16 third place trophies. He asks if that is enough. Wilbur feels that should be enough. If we need to get additional trophies and mail them to some winners the winners are usually fine with that. Club members had no additional input and that plan is agreed upon. (No vote is taken.)
- Parking: Mac discusses the parking compromise that was necessary as the new covered Farmer's Market will not be ready in time. The market will get the half-block from Marion to East Dale and the club gets East Dale to Warren. We have asked the city to give us Washington street from Newts to City Cab. We would be giving up 150 feet to gain 210 feet.
- **Registration**: Registration will take place on Warren Street. We will not be using Shelby Savings Bank parking lot this year at all.
- Volunteers: Additional volunteers are needed by Mac and Renee, Iverson and Wilbur volunteered to help Mac.
- Goody bags: any "goody items" will go in the registration packets and may be given to Treasure.
- **Shared expenses:** BREMC and Buffalo Creek Gallery will be sharing the expense for a police patrol person and a port-a-potty. BREMC covers the officer and the gallery covers the port-a-potty.
- Signage: Mac indicates that we have reached out to so many clubs (promoted the event) that we need do increased signage this year. Club agrees with that.
 Consequently someone is needed to pick up our four large signs with a pick-up truck. We also have 100 election-style signs we can utilize. It is noted that we need good signage for the registration area. Wilbur will keep the Healey signs.
- Executive committee will meet next week to go over final details. Info and the date will be emailed to those members.

Wilbur & Lundy Wright for work coordinating the basket / raffle which succeeded as a silent auction.


Tom Greene who continued his support and coaching that began last year.
