CHRIS SHARES MAINTENANCE TIPS FOR YOUR CLASSIC



Chirs Monroe, owner of **Monroe Tires**, shared some maintenance tips to help keep your classic on the road. Here are some of the tips that he shared.

- ✂ Check your fluids often. Consider change them depending on the length of time they have been in the vehicle.
- ✂ Prevent moisture in your gas tank if your car will be sitting for any length of time. Use an additive to keep the gas fresh.
- ✂ Look at your tires – how old are they? It may be time to replace.
- ✂ Always carry your cell phone when driving – you can call someone to come get you when the car breaks down.
