By-Law Change Passed

On June 4, 2020, at a General Meeting of the Broad River European Motor Club, with the concurrence of the Executive Board, a motion was made, seconded, and passed by voice vote to change the following sections of the By-Laws.

PART V. OFFICERS, SECTION 1 (by adding), "The position of Secretary/Treasurer may be filled by one or two persons as needed at that time.

PART VI. OFFICERS/DUTIES Secretary/Treasurer, if this position is held by more than one member, then the duties of the Secretary are as follows.

The **Secretary** shall perform all duties incident to the Office of Secretary. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of BREMC and provide minutes to the newsletter editor for publication in the monthly newsletter. The Secretary shall be responsible for the record of By-Laws and Operation Manual. The Secretary will direct all necessary correspondence with all national affiliations.

The duties of the **Treasurer** are as follows: The Treasurer shall have custody of and be responsible for all funds and securities of BREMC. The Treasurer shall receive and give receipts for all payments to BREMC, and deposit all such payments in the name of BREMC in such bank or other depositories as the Executive Board may designate. The Treasurer will provide a financial statement at each monthly meeting.

The term of these offices will be for one year and will be limited to three consecutive terms:

III. **MAILING ADDRESS** BREMC's official address shall be as listed in the most recent issue of the Club's newsletter and shall be the address of the Treasurer or the address provided to the bank for sending statements.
