TIME TO PASS THE CUSTODIANSHIP TO ANOTHER

Hi Jack, was nice to see you at "The Pond" last Saturday. May I please ask you to send this message around to our club members letting them know that I've



decided that the time has come for me to pass custodianship of my 1954 R-Type Bentley on to the next generation. I became its owner in 2014 when I bought it in Long Beach, CA. from a person who owned it from 1972 until then. I flew out and drove it 4600 trouble free miles home. During the year 2017 it was in a restoration shop to have the engine rebuilt to "as new", and to have air conditioning and power steering installed. The leather upholstery is new. The interior wood trim has been professionally restored. Since 2017 I've done about 13,000 miles. It travels down the road keeping up with modern traffic at 65 to 75 mph and it can do that all day long. I'm prepared to pass ownership on to the next generation for a reasonable price. Anyone interested can do their homework to determine the value of an unrestored and unimproved 1954 R-Type Bentley to which can be added the cost of an engine rebuild and a/c and p/s installs. It never fails to start, and it never fails to get us to the intended destination in comfort.
